

FOUR-PATCH

WHITE

Cut four 2 1/2 x 4 1/2 " rectangles
Cut twelve 2 1/2" squares

PURPLE

Cut four 2 1/2 " squares

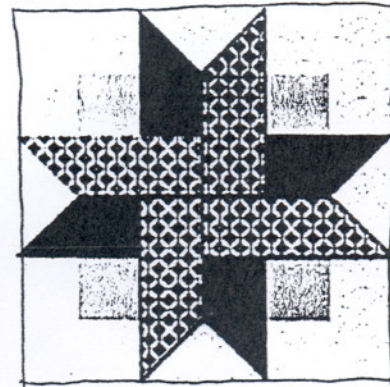
USING TWO DIFFERENT TURQUOISE FABRICS;

TURQUOISE #1

Cut four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

TURQUOISE #2

Cut four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles



1. Using turquoise rectangles and eight 2 1/2" white squares make a pieced half trapezoid.

FOLLOW THE DIRECTION OF THE DIAGONAL LINES OF THE WHITE SQUARES AS SHOWN IN THE DIAGRAM!!



(On wrong side of each white 2 1/2 " square draw a diagonal line. Place on right side of rectangle sew directly on the marked line. Cut away excess fabric to a 1/4 " and press toward the triangle.)

2. Sew remaining white 2 1/2 " squares to a purple 2 1/2" square.



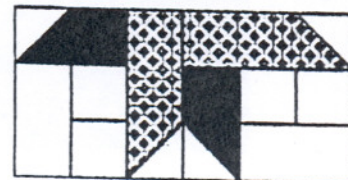
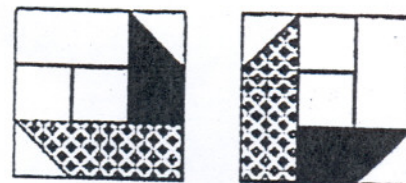
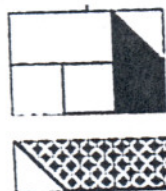
3. Sew a white rectangle to each 2 patch making sure the purple square is on the right side.



4. Sew this section to the turquoise #1 trapezoid



5. Sew turquoise #2 to bottom of square



6. Sew all four squares together.
