due June

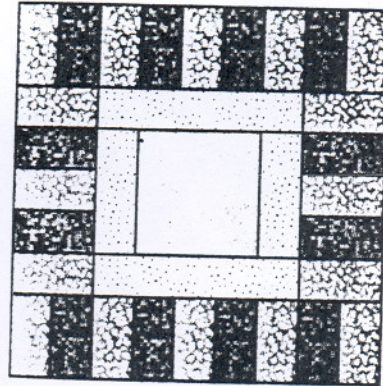
SQUARES AND LADDERS

BLACK OR WHITE ON WHITE (you choose)
Cut one 4 ½" square

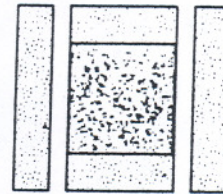
RED
Cut two 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles
Cut two 1 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

BLACK
Cut fourteen 1 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles

WHITE ON WHITE
Cut sixteen 1 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles

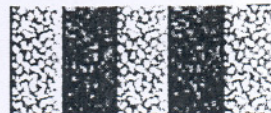


Sew red 1 ½" strips around 4 ½" square to form a border



Sew five black and white 1 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles together the long way in the pattern of:

white, black, white, black, white



Sew another five back and white rectangles together as above.

Sew these five "keys" to opposite sides of the black with red bordered square, you may have to trim these keys once they have been sewn on to the square

Sew ten more black and white 1 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles together in the pattern of:

black, white, black, white, black, white, black, white, black, white



Sew another ten more black and white rectangles together as above.

Sew the ten "keys" to one side of the block starting with a black "key". Repeat on the other side starting with a black key. (First black key on the row of ten will be in opposite corners)
