

Disappearing 9 patch

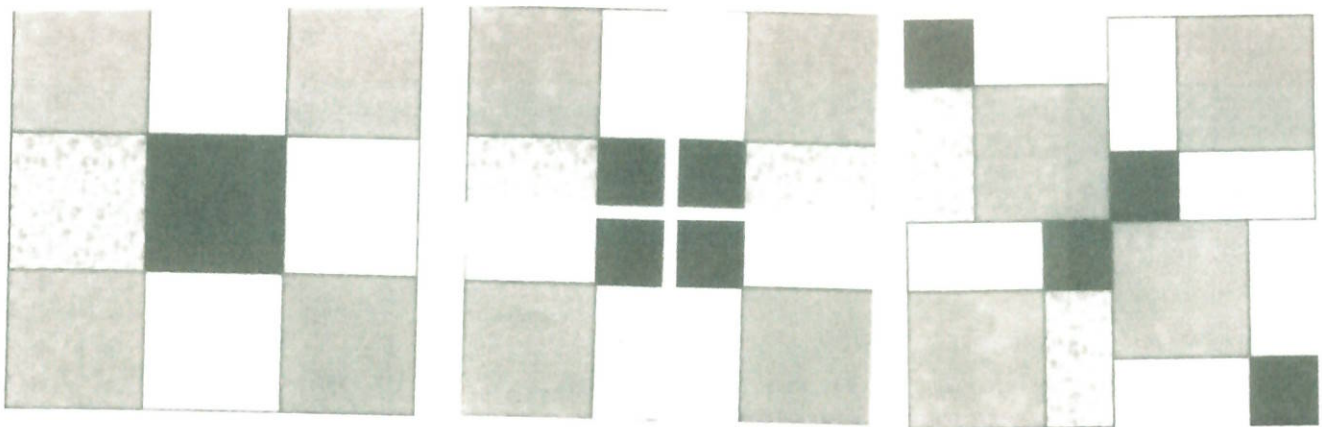
Materials

- 5 - soft patterned, with one darker; 5 in x 5 in squares
- 4 - 5 in x 5 in squares in cream/white

Make a 9 patch block combining 5 color squares with 4 white ones. Use darker tones for the center square for contrast. You can put the blocks in any way you want.

Iron the 9 patch block and cut it in half and then in half again. Use the middle point of the block and cut top to bottom and then side to side.

Change the resulting smaller blocks around to form a disappearing 9 patch block like below (or many other ways.)



Stitch together and iron flat.

Assemble making sure the small squares in each block face the same way.
